Code of Conduct for coaches, assistants and volunteers

- Consider the well-being and safety of club members before the development of performance.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with club members, coaches and other volunteers, based on mutual trust and respect.
- Follow all instructions given by the coach and the club.
- Encourage club members to value their performances and not just results.
- Encourage and guide club members to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- Encourage and guide club members to participate in the activities to the best of their ability.
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play).
- Set a good example to club members by adopting a consistently high standard of behaviour and appearance.
- Do not influence club members to obtain personal benefit or reward.
- ✓ Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibited substances.
- Report any concerns to the coach or to a club committee member.
- Treat as confidential any personal information gained about club members
